Mr. Kalin, as requested, we contacted the NYSDEC wetland biologist, Ms Heather Gierloff, in charge of the area where the project is located to find out if the wetland on the property is regulated by the NYSDEC. I also requested Ms Gierloff verify if the wetland was connected to any other NYSDEC regulated wetland. In the attached e-mail, Ms. Gierloff states that she visited the site and found no connections to the nearby NYSDEC wetlands, and that the site is not mapped currently by NYSDEC, therefore the wetland on the property is not regulated by the NYSDEC.

The wetland on the site would be regulated by both the town and the ACOE, therefore you would need a permit from the Town and the ACOE if the project disturbs the wetland, no permit would be required from the NYSDEC for this matter.
