Extension Studies in Dover, New York

Dover is located 70 miles from NYC and offers a serene natural environment away from the hustle-bustle of city living. This setting provides an atmosphere of spiritual enrichment through Christian living, including community Chapel services, prayer meetings and numerous Christian fellowship opportunities.

The Dover site is just minutes away from World Olivet Assembly's headquarters and ministry offices, giving students an opportunity for dynamic collaboration and access to an international network of friends, colleagues and leaders that will last a lifetime.



Extension Studies in New York City

New York City is a dynamic intersection of world languages and cultures — a fertile mission field and ideal center for cooperation with churches and para-church ministries. Field experience in New York City fosters spiritual maturity and valuable ministry skills.

The most densely populated city in the United States with over 8 million people, NYC exerts a significant impact upon commerce, finance, media, art, fashion, research, technology, education and entertainment and is described as the cultural and financial capital of the world. Just 51 percent of New Yorkers speak only English at home, while the other 49 percent speak languages from across the globe, according to a Census Bureau's American Community Survey.

Olivet University's theology courses in New York City offer students an opportunity to learn in a classroom and participate in multi-cultural outreach in connection with our ministry affiliates.
