LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF 2005

A LOCAL LAW AMENDING LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF 1999 GRANTING PARTIAL TAX EXEMPTION OF REAL PROPERTY OWNED BY CERTAIN PERSONS WITH LIMITED INCOME OF 65 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER

Section 1. Purpose and Authorization

This local law is enacted pursuant to Section 467 of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York to provide a partial exemption from taxation for certain senior citizens at the increased income levels provided in this law.

Section 2.

Chapter 131, Article II, Section 131-3 is amended as follows:

A. The percentage of partial exemption from real property taxation, applied to the following annual income ranges, pursuant to Subdivision 3 of § 467 of the Real Property Tax Law, shall be amended as follows:

<u>Income Range</u>	<u>Exemption Percentage</u>
\$24,000 or less	50%
More than \$24,000 but less than \$25,000	45%
\$25,000 or more but less than \$26,000	40%
\$26,000 or more but less than \$27,000	35%
\$27,000 or more but less than \$27,900	30%
\$27,900 or more but less than \$28,800	25%
\$28,800 or more but less than \$29,700	20%
\$29,700 or more but less than \$30,600	15%
\$30,600 or more but less than \$31,500	10%
\$31,500 or more but less than \$32,400	5%

B. Any exemption provided by this Section shall be computed after all of the partial exemptions allowed by law have been subtracted from the total amount assessed.

Section 3. Separability

If any part or provision of this Local Law or the application thereof to any person or circumstance be adjudged invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall be confined in its operation to the part of the provision or application directly involved in the

controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered and shall not affect or impair the validity of the remainder of this Local Law or the application thereof to other persons or circumstances, and the Town Board of the Town of Dover hereby declares that it would have passed this Local Law or the remainder thereof had such invalid application or invalid provision been apparent.

Section 5. Repeal

All ordinances, local laws, and parts thereof inconsistent with this Local Law, are hereby repealed.

Section 6. Effective Date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
